ACB nabs ASI for taking ₹15,000 bribe in Tonk

The Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) apprehended Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI) Shankarlal from the women's police station in Tonk district for accepting a bribe of Rs 15,000. The bribe was taken from a complainant in exchange for resolving a complaint filed by the complainant's wife at the Tonk Mahila Police Station. ASI Shankarlal had initially demanded Rs 20,000 for the resolution. The arrest was made on the spot by an ACB team led by Additional SP Vijay Swarnakar from ACB Kota. The operation was carried out within the police station premises, ensuring that the accused was caught red-handed. This action underscores the ACB's commitment to combating corruption within law enforcement agencies.

30.6 KG GANJA WORTH RS 15.32 LAKHS SEIZED, 2 ARRESTED

Abducted from Tripura, minor rescued from Jpr after 9 mnths

ing from her native area in September, 2023.

In a joint operation with local police, Rajasthan police traced the location of the minor girl. She was rescued on May 11 from Rajasthan village.

Upon receiving the information, the police had initiated a probe into the matter and traced the minor girl in Raj. Police found that she went to the village near Jaipur without informing her family. The police also found that a woman, a resident of Raj, helped the minor girl reach the village.

Father arrested for attempted arson in Jodhpur

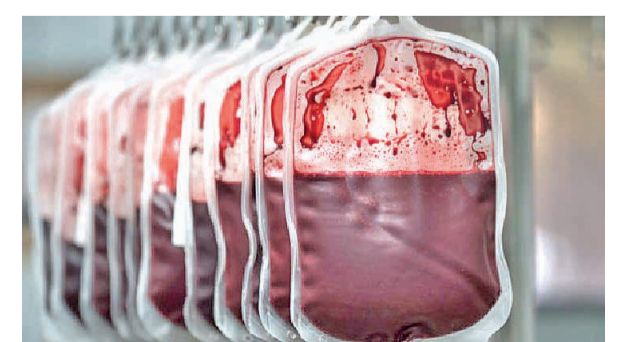

450 units of blood spoiled due to negligence of drug officers in Jpr

In a significant oversight, the negligence of drug officers has resulted in the deterioration of 450 units of blood at the capital's Jeevandaat Blood Center. The center's license was revoked on February 8 following a mutual dispute. Prior to this revocation, the staff destroyed 47 units of expired blood components, but their investigation report failed to specify the quantity of blood components or their expiration dates.



Subsequently, 440 units of packed red blood cells (PRBC) and 33 units of random donor platelets (RDP) expired before the license termination. During the initial inspection, these blood units were transferred to

a government facility. The then-Commissioner deemed the negligence of the drug officers to be extremely serious. On the advice of the Medical Minister, a chargesheet has been issued to the responsible authorities.

The scorching heat continued in Rajasthan where the highest temperature was recorded in Barmer at 46.5 degrees Celsius.

Most parts of the state are experiencing intense heat. According to the weather centre, this phase will continue for another week. During this period, warnings of heat waves have been issued in many areas. According to the Met Centre Jaipur, the maximum temperature on Friday was 46.5 degrees in Barmer, 46.4 degrees in Dholpur, 46.3 degrees in Fatehpur (Sikar), 46 degrees in Phalodi, 45.9 degrees in Piloni (Jhunjhunu), 45.8 degrees in Banasthali (Tonk) and Jaisalmer, 45.7 degrees in Churu, and 45.5 in Jodhpur and Karauli.

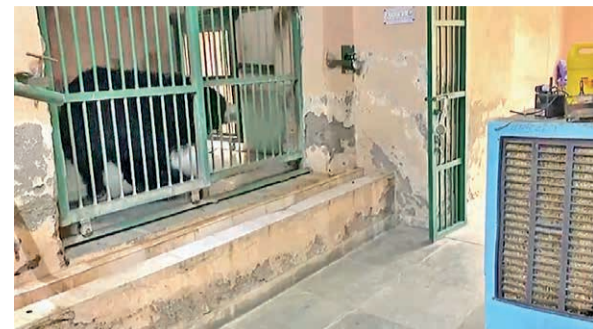

UDAIPUR COLLECTOR ISSUES ORDER TO PROTECT ANIMALS FROM WORKING BETWEEN 12-3 PM

Udaipur: In response to the intense heatwave, Udaipur District Collector Arvind Poswal has issued an order prohibiting the use of pack animals for labor during the hottest part of the day. The ban, effective from 12 PM to 3 PM, applies to animals such as camels, horses, oxen, mules, and donkeys. This decision aims to safeguard the health of these animals, which are at risk of heat-related illnesses due to the extreme temperatures. Violations of this order will be dealt with under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960. Collector Poswal emphasized that this measure is taken from a humane perspective, ensuring the well-being of working animals during the severe summer heat. The administration urges residents to comply with this directive to prevent undue suffering and maintain health of their animals. **Ravi Sharma**

I-T raids on ARL: Txn of ₹100 cr suspicious

Income tax raids and surveys continued for the second day at ARL Group, the country's largest asbestos sheet manufacturer and involved in cement corrugated roofs and pipe production and building construction. In income tax raids, success is being claimed in catching the tactics adopted by the group to save income tax. In investigation conducted so far, officials are considering expenditure of around Rs 100 cr as suspicious. Apart from this, it has also been revealed that ARL is also showing many tricks to save income in sale of houses.



On the second day of the Income Tax raids conducted in RIICO's Bagru Ind Area and Bindaayaka, officials are suspecting that some of documents used in making wasteful expenditure are linked to bogus firms. I-T officials are reported to have seized cash worth Rs 70 lakh, investment worth crores in property and jewelry.

Food Safety team raids in VKI, seizes misbranded 'Shree Saras' Ghee 13,700 litres spurious ghee seized

Under the supervision of Food Safety and Drug Control Commissioner Iqbal Khan a continuous campaign is being run against adulteration.

On Friday, Pankaj Ojha, Addl Commissioner Food Safety and Drug Control, led a raid on Sanyam Enterprises at VKI Road No. 9, seizing approximately 13,700 liters of substandard spurious ghee misbranded as Saras Ghee.

The investigation revealed that the ghee was brought to Jaipur from Daman near Gujarat and sold in Rajasthan cities.

Fake NOC case: Probe to come under SIT's ambit

Will the transplants done in SMS come under the ambit of SIT investigation? Organ transplant done in SMS super specialty block were back in discussion on Friday.

First India was the first to disclose on April 24 that transplant through fake NOC had occurred even in super specialty of SMS. Figures also revealed in the report prepared by High Level Investigation Committee that organ transplant was done on 54 patients in last one year. Out of these, 8 patients were transplanted in non-related category whereas there is no organ



transplant approval committee in SSB hospital.

These transplants were done with alleged NOC from SMS hospital committee itself. It is surprising that no committee meeting has been held in SMS in the last one year. Then the question is, from whom transplants were done in SSB hospital after taking NOC. Did SSB Hospital also do the transplant on Gaurav Singh's fake NOC?

HC stays encroachment removal in Odwara

The Rajasthan High Court has intervened in the ongoing demolition drive in Odwara village of Jalore district, granting significant relief to the villagers by imposing a stay on the removal of encroachments. Justice Vineet Mathur's bench issued the order to

halt the demolition during the hearing held in the High Court on Friday. The controversy erupted on Thursday when the demolition drive commenced in Odwara village, resulting in removal of several encroachments on first day.

During the court proceedings, the AAG Rajesh Panwar represented the govt's stance, while the lawyers for the petitioners argued that the affected individuals had been residing in these houses for 80 years.

It's been a thrilling 17th edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL) so far with record-breaking totals, soaring run rates and countless sixes being quite the flavour of the season. As the race for the playoffs gets almost complete with three spots being clinched by Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR), Rajasthan Royals (RR) and Sunrisers Hyderabad (SRH), the dominance of bat over ball has been more than obvious. In a virtual knock out clash, Chennai Super Kings (CSK) and Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) will battle for the final spot on 18th May.

Besides the humongous totals, this season will also be remembered for excellent consistency by some players. IPL 2024 so far has had 1,133 sixes, making it the season with the highest number of maximums. Yet, there have been a few bowlers who have made life difficult for batsmen.

Top on this list is Jasprit Bumrah. He is just 2 behind Harshal Patel with 20 wickets but has been phenomenal with his control all through. His average of 16.80 is the best but even his economy rate is stunning - 6.48! To understand it in a better perspective, this is the lowest among all bowlers this season!

In fact, Bumrah was the highest wicket-taker till Harshal crossed his tally in the last game. Experts suggest that might be because most batsmen try to play out the 'dangerous Bumrah

spells' and not give their wicket away. It is a hallmark of his genius and control that despite that Bumrah still manages to scalp so many wickets. In a season where Australian pacers Pat Cummins and Mitchell Starc are also present, it is Bumrah who has been the dominant fast-bowler of the season!

Among the spinners, Varun Chakaravathy has been brilliant along with Indian regulars- Yuzvendra Chahal and Kuldeep Yadav. Varun has taken 18 wickets so far and will potentially take a few more since his team (KKR) is already in the playoffs. He has been one of the main reasons why KKR find themselves at the top of the points table. His mystery spin has bamboozled most batsmen.

While it has been a season of comebacks, fans would be happy to see the return of the KUL-CHA jodi back in action for the T20 World Cup. Kuldeep is in great form over the last

year but Yuzi Chahal has made his presence felt due to his performance in this IPL. He has picked up 17 wickets so far but what is more impressive is the way he has taken those wickets. Chahal has invariably been introduced in the middle overs when there is a strong partnership on and the batsmen have got their eye in. He not only throttles the run scoring but also breaks set partnerships with his wily leggies.

Meanwhile, Kuldeep has been consistent and has 16 wickets but at a miserly economy rate of 8.6. Although his team, Delhi Capitals (DC) is out of the competition, Kuldeep's contribution kept them in the race for the playoffs spot till the very end. Indian fans will pray that he maintains his bowling form in the World Cup as well.

But it's the batsmen who have provided the special thrills. On the batting side, no one comes even close to the champion himself, Vi-

rat Kohli. Many doubted his credentials in the shortest format of the game but Kohli proved his detractors wrong once again by scoring 661 runs in 13 matches. This includes a century and 5 fifties and a strike rate of 155 to go with it. RCB were down and out in the middle of the season but Kohli's brilliance dragged them back in the knock-outs' race. Now, he will once again be the key in the must win game against CSK to decide the final spot in the top 4.

Rituraj Gaikwad, Riyan Parag and Travis Head are the others in the run scoring list behind Kohli. But Head deserves a special mention for the sheer impact he has had for SRH at the top of the order. His 533 runs have come at an average of 53 but at a strike rate of 200! Australia will hope that he remains the 'destroyer-in-chief' even in the T20 World Cup!

India may not have footballers like Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo, but those who have led Indian soccer are in a class of their own. PK Banerjee, Subrata Pal, Bhaichung Bhutia, and Sunil Chhetri, among others, have made outstanding contributions to keep India's soccer flag flying high. In a cricket-obsessed country, it is no mean accomplishment to be counted among the country's best sportspersons.

Sunil Chhetri deciding to hang his boots is, therefore, sad news for soccer lovers. It is even sadder to learn that no one is there to immediately fill the void of a striker. Under intense criticism from South Africa, which has accused Israel of committing genocide in Gaza and called for international legal action, Israel staunchly defended its actions in Palestine before the International Court of Justice. Israel's Deputy Attorney General for International Law Gilad Noam defended his country's action in Rafah and accused South Africa of "ulterior motive" for urging Israeli withdrawal from the area as it wanted "a military advantage for Hamas". Noam denied his country committed any genocide in Rafah. Accusing South Africa of "distorting statements", another Israeli representative said Israel was simply defending itself. There was no genocidal intent on the part of Israel he said. Critics called Israel's defence "dishonest".

Israel has come under attack even from its friend and ally, the US, for killing innocent women and children in Gaza and Rafah. It has also been criticized for blocking aid supply to the Palestinians who are on the verge of starvation. An estimated 35,000 Palestinians have been killed in the fighting so far.

Israel told the UN court that any other country would do the same. It held Hamas responsible for the pain and suffering of the Palestinian people and said that "it wishes no harm to Palestinian civilians". Noam told the judges, "This war, like all wars, is tragic and terrible for Israelis and Palestinians and it has exacted a terrible human price." Earlier, some Republican senators threatened the International Criminal Court with US sanctions if it insisted on arrest warrants against senior Israeli officials. With the US by its side, Israel need not worry about the ICJ either.

On Bangladesh, Nepal and Bhutan Sri Lanka: Looking at the last 10 years, there has been great improvement in regional connectivity and inter-dependence. Look at Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan and Sri Lanka. You can definitely see that in Bangladesh and Nepal, there is road and rail connectivity, fuel pipelines, increased volume of business, and access to ports in Bangladesh is very big.

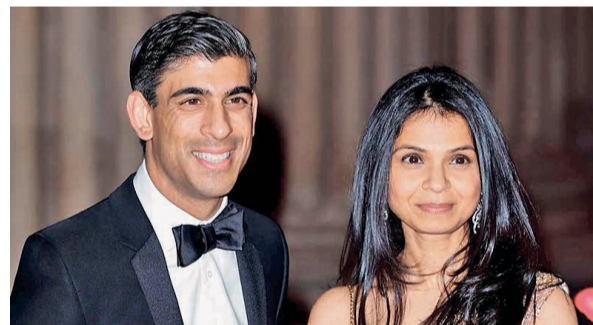
On Maldives: Our development projects are doing well. We had some political turbulence, which we are hopeful about managing. Things are a little bit more constructive after the visit of my counterpart.

On China: We need to put a national security filter. Where China is concerned, we will still encourage people in this country to manufacture in India and procure from India. We are not completely and utterly prohibiting people from working with China, but we would much rather you work with Indian companies if the option is available.

JAISHANKAR SLAMS PAKISTAN WITH A MESSAGE

New Delhi: "If they wind down this industry they have created, then people will treat them as normal neighbours. If they make this their core competence, that will define their image. We have been straight with them. They have to make up their mind. Part of the problem is that after 2019, the Imran Khan government took a number of steps that downgraded relations. We did not do, they did. Our messaging is very clear", EAM S Jaishankar said on Friday.

last year to 245th with an estimated wealth of GBP 651 million, making them the "wealthiest people to call 10 Downing Street home".

Murty's earnings are said to far exceed that of her husband as financial statements published in February are quoted to say Sunak made GBP 2.2 million in 2022-23 compared to Murty's estimated GBP 13 million in dividends over the past year.

Indian economy's growth rate projection for this year has been raised by 0.7 per cent to 6.9 per cent from the forecast made in January by the UN and it retains its position as the world's fastest-growing large economy.

The better outlook is fueled by lower inflation, robust exports, and increased foreign investments, Hamid Rashid, the chief of the UN's Global Economic Monitoring Branch, said on Thursday. "The drivers (of higher projection) are very simple: inflation has come down significantly, and that means the fiscal position is not as constrained as in other countries," he said.

2024 that has revised upwards India's growth projections for 2024, with the country's economy now forecast to expand by close to seven per cent this year.

In India, labour market indicators have also improved amid robust growth and higher labour force participation, it said. India's government remains committed to gradually reduce the fiscal deficit, while seeking to increase capital investment.

Israeli military finds bodies of three hostages in Gaza

The Israeli military said Friday its troops in Gaza found the bodies of three Israeli hostages taken by Hamas during its Oct. 7 attack, including German-Israeli Shani Louk.

A photo of 22-year-old Shani's twisted body in the back of a pickup truck ricocheted around the world and brought to light

the scale of the militants' attack on communities in southern Israel. The military identified the other two bodies as those of a 28-year-old woman, Amit Buskila, and a 56-year-old man, Itzhak Gelerenter. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu called the deaths "heart-breaking," saying, "We will return all of our hostages, both the living and the dead."

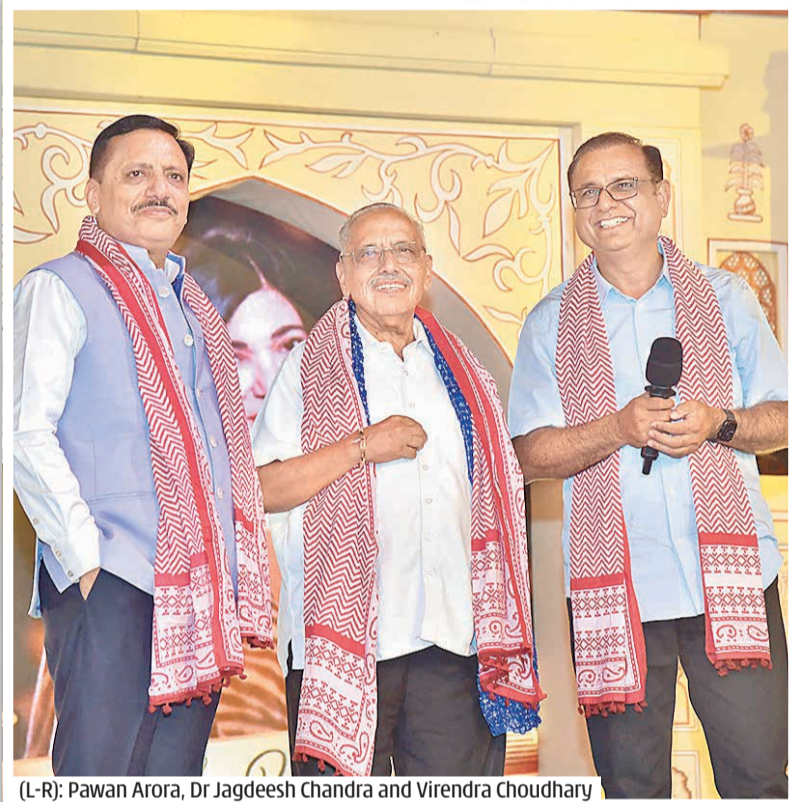
