Now 33% reservation for women in Parliament and in the state assemblies will become a law and will be implemented after census and delimitation, a

INDIA-CANADA RIFT: CROSSROADS OF DIPLOMACY

BILLIONS AT STAKE!

Economic and social talks between India and Canada have taken a hit as tension rises more after Prime Minister Justin Trudeau said authorities were investigating "credible allegations" linking Delhi's agents to the murder of Sikh separatist leader, Hardeep Singh Nijjar. However, on Tuesday, New Delhi dismissed the allegations as "absurd", and asked Canada instead to crack down on anti-India elements operating in its territory.

HERE ARE THE CHALLENGES FOR BOTH COUNTRIES



TRADE: Canada said this month it had paused talks on the proposed treaty with India. Steady growth has seen goods trade rising to \$8 billion in 2022, with Indian exports to Canada touching \$4 billion.

STUDENTS: India is largest source country for international students in Canada. In 2022, data rose 47% to nearly 3,20,000, 40% of total overseas students.

SIKHS: Analysts say the worsening ties could affect economic interests of thousands of Sikhs in India's Sikh-majority Punjab, since they have relatives in Canada, who remit millions back home.

TRAVEL PLANS: Travellers, globe trotters & transportation sector have been rattled by the sudden ramp-up in tensions between Canada and India.

I CALL UPON INDIA TO WORK WITH US: JUSTIN

Canadian PM Justin Trudeau on Thursday said, "I had a direct talk, with PM Modi, I shared my concerns in no uncertain terms. We call upon GoI to take seriously this matter and to work with us to shed full transparency and ensure accountability and justice in this matter."

India on Thursday suspended visa services in Canada with immediate effect. "Important notice from Indian Mission: Due to operational reasons, with effect from 21 September 2023, Indian visa services have been suspended till further notice," reads a notice on BLS website.

CRIME ACROSS RAJASTHAN

Three accused held from Kardhani area used to extort money from people by posing as policemen

Three held with opium worth ₹8L, posed as cops

Rajasthan police have arrested three people here on Thursday and recovered 1.64 kg of high-quality opium from them on Thursday, officials said. According to the police, the price of this opium in the international market is around Rs 8 lakh. The arrested accused also extorted money from people by posing as policemen, they said. Additional Director General of Police (Crime) Dinesh MN said Subhash Jat, Jaipal Sepat alias JP and Babulal were arrested in Kardhani police station area of Jaipur.

They were living at a rented accommodation in Govindpura area, he said.

During the search of their car, 1.64 kg of opium was recovered from the dashboard. Following this, the trio was arrested and booked under NDPS Act. During interrogation, they revealed that they brought this opium from Chittorgarh. Several criminal cases have already been registered against Jaipal and Babulal. They used to take rooms on rent in Jaipur, pose as policemen and extort money from people by threatening them, police said.

Woman jumps into water tank with kids, die; husband held

A married woman along with her two children jumped into a tank in her home after a fight with her husband on Thursday here. The accused has been taken into custody. Neighbours took all the three to the hospital, where doctors declared them dead.

SOLVING THE GOD PARADOX

MORE ABOUT CONSCIOUSNESS

It turns out that God doesn't need to be accepted or rejected. By any name, the creator of the universe created it out of itself. God became the universe, if you want to put it that way. But if you strip it down to the nub, consciousness became the universe. Everything that baffles our habit of either/or thinking is resolved once you adopt the perspective of wholeness.

Like a richly fulfilling life, the cosmos is richly fulfilling because it does what it wants to do, following rules when it wants to, ignoring them on a spree of free thinking and behavior when rules feel too confining. Fortunately for human existence, cosmic consciousness decided that it wanted to be loving, compassionate, blissful, creative, and evolutionary when it comes down to it.

All our detours into doubt, habit, conditioning, misbehavior, anger, revenge, and unnecessary suffering aren't part of the basic setup. They are our creative impulses taking a perverse turn. The greatest gift bestowed on humans is the evolutionary impulse, and if other universes lack this gift, it would be better not to inhabit them.

The fact that every society remains divided over religion in the modern world means that the age-old question, "Does God exist?" remains in limbo. Paradoxically, the camp that needs God to exist and the opposite camp, that needs God to disappear, holds equal sway. But there is a way to solve the God paradox.

First, outrageous as this will sound to partisans on either side, the following propositions show the way to an answer.

- God did not create the universe.
- The Biblical story of creation in the Book of Genesis is wrong. Religious dogma in every culture is just as wrong.
- Militant atheism is wrong.

I am not insisting on these points but offering them as a starting point, because we need a clean slate. If the word "wrong" bothers you, substitute "hasn't worked out." These statements can cause strong reactions, but this doesn't matter right now. We are looking past personal opinions to reveal some underlying clarity.

In the modern secular world, atheism appears to have the upper hand. The notion of creating the universe in seven days can easily be ridiculed, and if someone insists that God is the Creator, the atheist position is simple: who created God? Here we begin to see a glimmer of an answer, because "Who created God?" poses an unavoidable issue. Where did creation begin? This issue plagues not just religion but cosmology. If there is a universe filled with nearly infinite universes, where did the first one come from? Going backward, forward, or sideways into alternative universes



doesn't solve the issue of finding an actual source for creation.

Militant atheists, still championed by the last old-fashioned anti-religionist, Richard Dawkins, are working from an outmoded model as creaky as outmoded physics. Leaving aside sheer rhetoric (lumping all believers as superstitious, tracing religion to the primitive state of Stone Age societies, etc.), atheism cannot hold water until it acknowledges that physics has arrived at a new set of suppositions.

Therefore, the old-fashioned bedrock of atheism, which makes science the enemy of religion (or more crudely, reason the enemy of superstition) has collapsed. A causeless God outside space and time is nothing to ridicule. Something is causeless and outside space and time if it is to qualify as the cause of the universe. The arrival of quantum mechanics more than a century ago established that the quantum field doesn't obey normal cause and effect. Instead, reality begins as a field of possibilities, and this field is causeless because every subatomic particle and every quantum event is entangled with every other. A fixed event in the physical universe is spontaneously created, like taking a ladle of quantum soup out of the infinite pot of quantum soup.

the creative, evolutionary impulse come from? In a word, what created creativity? This is the question that morphed out of "Who created the Creator?"

The answer that we have been striving for, it turns out, must contain contradictory qualities that beggar any kind of either/or logic. The source of creation doesn't need a creator. The source is beyond thought and perception, yet it gives rise to all thoughts and perceptions. The source is inconceivable yet gives rise to everything we conceive of, including science and mythology. The source is transcendent in the most radical way—it is a realm of pure, infinite possibilities.

Taken all together, these aren't head-spinning propositions that are circular and illogical. They are the answer to where the universe came from. The source of creation is pure awareness, nothing else. No other answer suffices. Leaving aside all religious and anti-religious opinions, all competing philosophies, even all worldviews, a single unbroken thread runs through human existence: consciousness. Looking at your own awareness, you will see into the mirror of cosmic awareness.

Your awareness is a field full of possibilities. It gels into thoughts and feelings constantly. You are motivated by using attention and intention, which gives you goals and desires. You are capable of creative activity, whether or not you take advantage of this. You know that you exist, which is the seed of self-awareness. Most important of all, none of the above had to be invented. They are aspects of one innate thing: consciousness itself.

GUTERRES MAKES APPEAL FOR NET ZERO EMISSION

United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres opened the special climate ambition summit with a doomsday-like warning. "Humanity has opened the gates to hell," Guterres said while making another impassioned appeal for action. "Horrendous heat is having horrendous effects. Distraught farmers watching crops carried away by floods. Sweltering temperatures are spawning diseases," he said.

But humanity is in no hurry to reverse the frightening changes. As nations have depended on fossil fuel for so long, they dither from early switchover to alternative forms of energy. Even as Guterres spoke, British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak announced softening of his green policy the implementation of which will be delayed by five years. In what he called a "more pragmatic approach" to achieving net zero carbon emission the sale of petrol and diesel cars will now begin from 2035.

Net zero emission by 2050 was agreed upon in the Paris climate conference and by 2030 it has to be reduced by 45 percent. Will the UK meet the deadline?

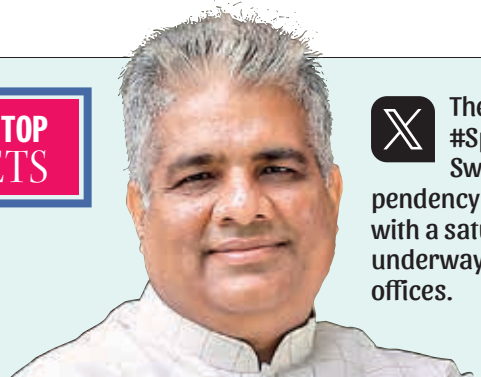
The rise in borrowings could be due to high medical expenses during the pandemic and also for clearing past debts. India's medical inflation is estimated to be 12 percent, which is the highest in Asia. The cost of medical treatment in India has doubled in the last five years. Economists doubt if the consumption-led growth is sustainable.

State Bank of India's research unit, however, dismissed the assessment of decline in household income. "...this is completely misleading as household savings must be looked into as a sum total of physical and financial savings", the Group Chief Economic Advisor of SBI was quoted as saying. This may be true as GST on purchase of property adds to a consumer's financial burden, the high cost of medical treatment and education also cannot be denied.

SC refuses to interfere with order

CAUVERY RIVER DISPUTE Directing Karnataka to release 5,000 cusecs water a day to Tamil Nadu

The Supreme Court on Thursday refused to interfere with the order of the Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) and the CWRC directing the Karnataka government to release 5,000 cusecs of water per day to Tamil Nadu for 15 days.

The Cauvery Water Regulation Committee (CWRC) in its September 12 order, which was upheld by CWMA, directed Karnataka to release 5,000 cusecs (cubic foot per second) of water every day for the next 15 days to Tamil Nadu.

A bench of Justices BR Gavi, PS Narasimha and Prashant Kumar Mishra said it was not inclined to entertain Tamil Nadu's

plea challenging the CWMA decision on the ground that it was facing a drought-like situation due to rain deficit.

The bench noted that bodies like CWMA & CWRC, which have experts from the India Mete-

rological Department (IMD), & those on agriculture & water resource management, have considered all relevant aspects like drought, deficit rainfall, water level in the river & only then passed the order. "We are therefore of

the considered view that the factors which have been taken into consideration by both the authorities cannot be said to be irrelevant or extraneous. In that view, we are not inclined to interfere with the orders," the bench said.

CAN'T RELEASE CAUVERY WATER TO TAMIL NADU DUE TO DROUGHT: KARNATAKA TO CENTRE

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar on Thursday called on Union Jal Shakti Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat in New Delhi and informed him of the state's inability to comply with the Cauvery Water Management Authority's order of releasing 5,000 cusecs of water per day till September 28 to Tamil Nadu, citing a drought-like situation. 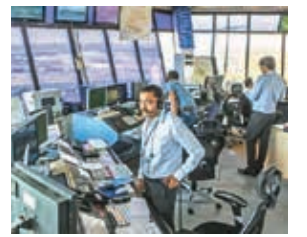
DGCA enforces new norms for watch duty hours at 57 airports

The regulations regarding 'Watch Duty Time Limitation (WDTL) and rest requirements for Air Traffic Controllers (ATCOs)' are being implemented at the 57 airports from Thursday, DGCA said.

Curfew clamped in Imphal Valley; mobs try to storm police stations

Curfew was imposed in entire Imphal valley on Thursday following violent protests for release of five men, including a trained cadre of a banned terror outfit, who were arrested earlier this week on charges of extortion.

Earlier, over 10 people were injured when Manipur security forces fired tear gas shells on protesters for trying to storm police stations and court arrest demanding the unconditional release of the five arrested youths. police and RAF personnel deployed at strategic positions fired several rounds of tear gas shells to disperse the crowd. Similar attempts to enter Mayang Imphal police station in Imphal West district and Andro police station in Imphal East district were also reported.

Amaravati: In the wake of a remand prisoner allegedly succumbing to dengue fever in Rajamahendravaram central prison, where TDP chief N Chandrababu Naidu is currently lodged, party General Secretary Nara Lokesh on Thursday claimed that a conspiracy has been hatched to see that his father suffers a similar fate. Naidu was arrested on September 9 for alleged misappropriation of funds from the Skill Development Corporation, leading to an alleged loss of over ₹300 crore to the state government. He is currently serving a 14-day remand in the Rajamahendravaram central prison.

ANDHRA HIGH COURT GRANTS BAIL TO 79 TDP LEADERS IN CASES RELATED TO VIOLENCE

The court also directed the police not to arrest MLC Ram Bhoopal Reddy till further orders. With the High Court's orders, the TDP leaders lodged in jail in Chittoor, Madanapalle and Kadapa will be released. The court has asked them to appear before the police stations concerned every Tuesday. Another 30 leaders have filed anticipatory bail petitions in these two cases.

Man held for killing partner in Bhiwandi

Thane: A man was held on Thursday from North Dinajpur area of West Bengal for allegedly murdering a woman in Bhiwandi in Thane district, a police official said. The decomposed body of the woman, identified as Madhu Prajapati, was found in Ganesh Nagar and a murder case was filed due to the presence of multiple wounds, the police said.

Ujjain: Four of family found dead in house

Ujjain: A 40-year-old man was found hanging while his wife and two children were also found dead at their house in Ujjain city in Madhya Pradesh on Thursday, police said. Mohan Rathore, the man, is suspected to have poisoned his wife Mamta (35), son Lucky (12) and daughter Kanak (6) before ending his own life on the intervening night of Wednesday.

Families concerned over 'escalating tension' between India and Canada

Canada's allies in a bind as tensions rise with India over Sikh leader's murder

With India warning its citizens to "exercise utmost caution" while in Canada amid escalation of the diplomatic row between the two countries, the families of students and permanent residents, particularly the Hindus and Hindu-Canadians residing in the north American nation, are concerned about their well being.

As per official data, Canada is an attractive destination for Indians, especially students. A major chunk of them are from Punjab, Haryana, Gujarat and Delhi.

"We have been much concerned about the well being of both my children who are studying in Canada since the escalation of tension in diplomatic relations between India and Canada after the murder accusation," Ramesh Uppal, a resident of Ludhiana, told media.

INDIAN-ORIGIN MP SAYS CANADIAN HINDUS 'SOFT TARGETS', URGES THEM TO BE CALM, VIGILANT

New Delhi: The threat by designated terrorist Gurpatwant Singh Pannun asking all Indo-Canadian Hindus to leave the country has left the community shocked and terrified, said a Canadian MP of Indian origin as well as an organisation claiming the support of Hindus in Canada. He has also sought the expulsion of Indian High Commissioner Sanjay Verma. Indian-origin MP Chandra Arya, who has been vocal on the Khalistan issue, on Thursday urged the community to stay calm, vigilant.

MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS

- The Canadian government has rejected a travel advisory issued by India about security risks in Canada, saying it is one of the safest countries in the world, and called for calm amid the escalating diplomatic row between the 2 nations.
- The NIA has released the photographs of 10 men wanted in the vandalism of the Indian consulate in San Francisco in March.
- The probe agency has sought information about these men from the public which would lead to their "arrest or apprehension".
- Also, Canadian PM Justin Trudeau, during his visit to India for the G20 Summit, refused to stay at the presidential suite, and stayed at a regular room.

'SITUATION AFFECTING PEOPLE LIVING THERE'

New Delhi: Shiromani Akali Dal President and MP Sukhbir Singh Badal appealed to the Central Government to establish a good relationship with Canada soon to avoid 'increasing panic' among the citizens living there. Badal requested Home Minister Amit Shah to 'find a solution' over the matter soon.

LAWRENCE BISHNOI CLAIMS RESPONSIBILITY FOR KILLING OF RIVAL SUKHA DUNEKE IN CANADA

New Delhi: Lawrence Bishnoi, a gangster who is currently behind bars in Ahmedabad in a drugs smuggling case investigated by the National Investigation Agency (NIA), claimed responsibility for the killing of Sukhdool Singh Gill alias Sukha Duneke in Canada's Winnipeg, in a Facebook post. Duneke, an alleged ally of the Bamba gang, was shot dead by unidentified assailants on Wednesday. In the post, Bishnoi's gang said Duneke had played a major role in the killings of gangsters Gurlal Brar and Vicky Middkhera. The murders were planned by Duneke even when he was staying abroad, the gang alleged.

SPICY FOOD CAUSES ULCERS!

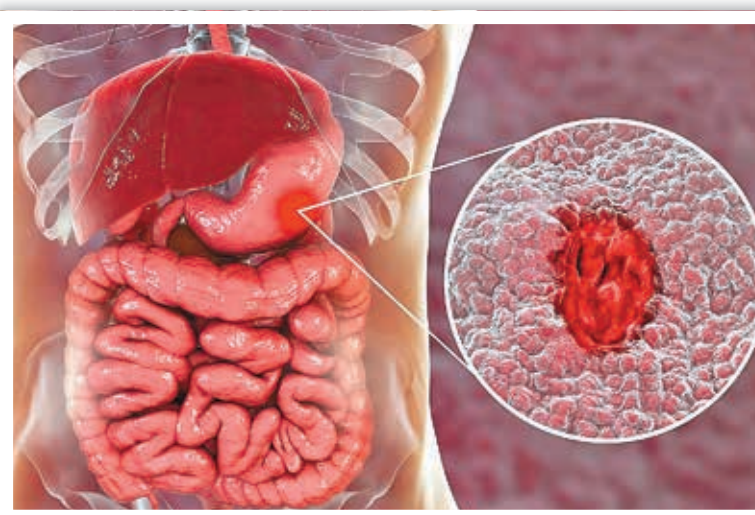
It is a common belief that we should avoid spicy food because spices may cause ulcers in the mouth and stomach. So many people complain with a degree of innocence about why they got ulcers in the stomach when their diet has always been bland! Researchers and experts working in this field agree that spicy foods do not cause ulcers either in the oral cavity or in the stomach. The only reason for the advice to avoid spicy food in such people is that spicy foods aggravate pain arising out of these ulcers but by themselves are not responsible for the

causation of these ulcers. The triggering factors for ulcer formation are either bacterial, viral or parasite infection of the intestine including the oral cavity. Sometimes trauma may lead to ulcers on the tongue and mucosa of the mouth. Many types of allergic reactions and chemotherapy

NSAIDs. Treating H. Pylori vigorously and avoiding offending painkillers may attain a cure in many people. The stress of modern lifestyle has also emerged as a strong trigger for stomach ulcer formation and hence, should be managed by counseling and lifestyle changes. Smoking should be strictly avoided and alcohol consumption be moderated. Sleep is a great healer hence, avoid mobile use after 9 pm and instead of mobile go for a book and a pillow for a relaxing sleep during the night. Restrict salt-preserved fish, meat and vegetables as well as processed, grilled and charcoal-cooked foods to a minimum. Herbs and many spices help in maintaining cardiovascular health. Cinnamon, turmeric and oregano belong to that category. Pepper in moderation has definitive health benefits.

Thus, we should look for causes other than spicy food for recurrent or persistent ulcers of the mouth or stomach otherwise the diagnosis would be missed. Finally, the prolonged use of ulcer drugs like omeprazole, and pantoprazole should be avoided as they may be harmful to muscle and bone health and also make you deficient in certain vitamins and prone to some infections.

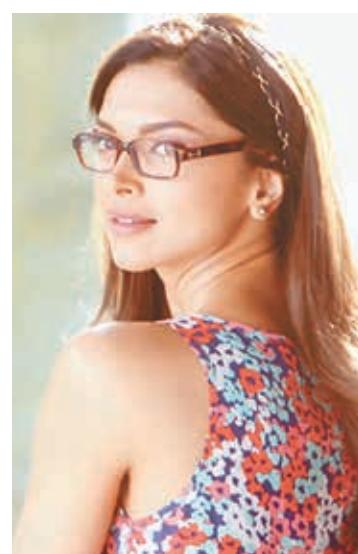

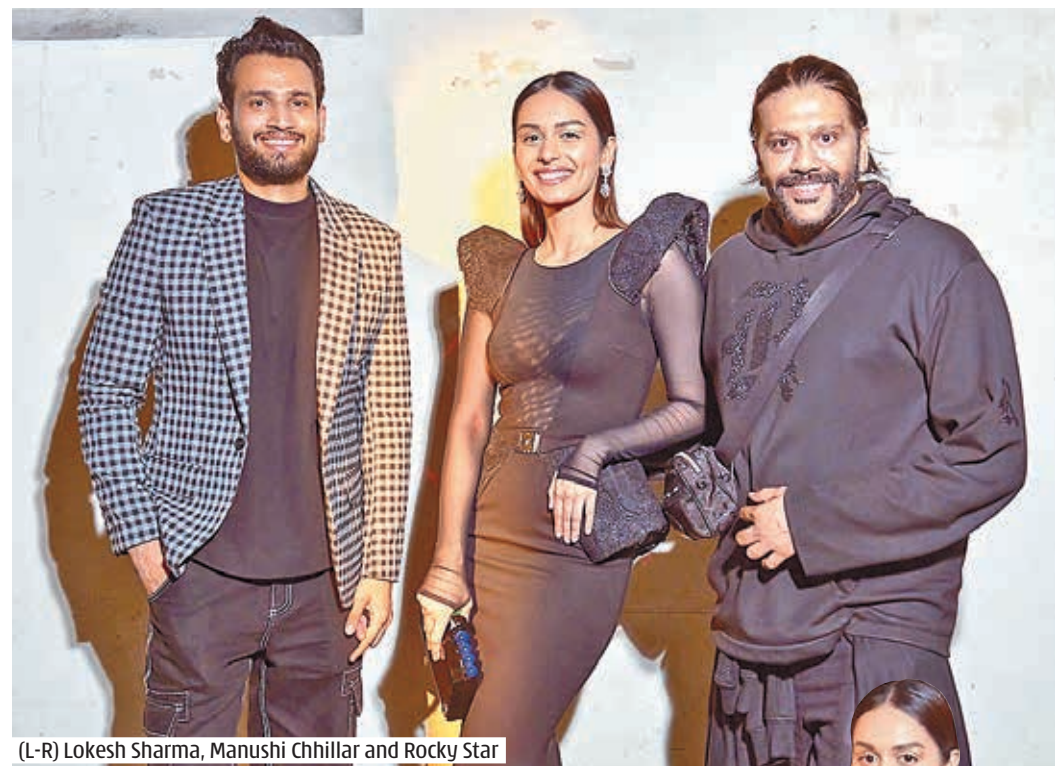
